Ordinance authorizing the Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) to set parking rates at the Kezar Stadium Parking Lot, Golden Gate Park Underground Parking Facility, and Marina Small Craft Harbor in accordance with Park Code provisions that authorize SFMTA rate-setting on park property; making conforming edits to the Park Code; increasing parking rates for berth-holders at the Marina Small Craft Harbor; and affirming the Planning Department's determination under the California Environmental Quality Act.

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17	Section 7	1. Environmental Findings.
18	The Plan	ning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in this
19	ordinance comp	oly with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public Resources
20	Code Sections	21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
21	Supervisors in I	File No and is incorporated herein by reference. The Board affirms this
22	determination.	
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- Section 2. Authority and Role of Municipal Transportation Agency Regarding Paid Parking at the Kezar Stadium Parking Lot, the Golden Gate Park Underground Parking Facility, and the Marina Small Craft Harbor.
- (a) Park Code Section 6.14 authorizes the Municipal Transportation Agency to identify locations suitable for the establishment of paid parking areas or zones on property under the jurisdiction of the Recreation and Park Commission, and to set rates for paid parking in such areas that are closely comparable to the rates set for similarly situated paid parking, provided, among other things, that the Board of Supervisors approves the location of the paid parking areas and the parking restrictions.
- (b) In accordance with Park Code Section 6.14, the Board of Supervisors approves the implementation of paid parking with rates set by the Municipal Transportation Agency and subject to approval by the Recreation and Commission at the Kezar Stadium Parking Lot, the Golden Gate Park Underground Parking Facility, and the Marina Small Craft Harbor. The Kezar Parking Lot is located at 825 Stanyan Street. The Golden Gate Park Underground Parking Facility is located under the Music Concourse area of Golden Gate Park. The Marina Small Craft Harbor is located at 3950 Scott Street and encompasses those certain areas in the vicinity of and including the Marina Green. The current parking rates at these facilities are adjusted for inflation but are otherwise fixed. The rates set by the Municipal Transportation Agency at those sites shall be comparable to the rates set for similarly situated parking, may increase or decrease in response to customer demand at particular times or on particular days or dates, and shall be intended to support recreation by encouraging the use of these facilities by recreational users, and by helping the Recreation and Park Department meet operating expenses, purchase or lease supplies, equipment and materials for the parks, and raise funds for future capital projects necessary to maintain existing levels of service.

1	(b) In accordance with Park Code Section 6.14, the Board of Supervisors approves
2	that the parking restrictions set forth in the Park Code, as amended by this ordinance and as
3	they may be amended in the future from time to time, shall apply to any such system of paid
4	parking.
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6	Section 3. The Park Code is hereby amended by revising Sections 6.01, 6.02, 6.10,
7	12.08, 12.11, and 12.35, to read as follows:
8	SEC. 6.01. OPERATION AND PARKING OF VEHICLES.
9	* * * *
10	(i) No person shall, in any park, allow any automobile or other vehicle to remain
11	parked in any parking lot space which is open for public use and for which a fee is charged for
12	parking, including, but not limited to Kezar Parking Lot, for a period of more than 24 hours after
13	the expiration of the period for which a fee is charged, unless otherwise allowed by permit.
14	* * * *
15	(k) No person shall, in any park, allow any automobile or any other vehicle that is
16	disabled to remain parked in any parking lot space which is open for public use and for which a
17	fee is charged for parking, including but not limited to Kezar Parking Lot, unless otherwise
18	allowed by permit.
19	
20	SEC. 6.02. TOWING OF VEHICLES.
21	(a) Whenever any member officer of the San Francisco Police Department, employee of
22	the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA), or employee or lessee authorized

by the Recreation and Park Department or Commission finds any vehicle parked in violation

of Sections 6.01(d), (e), (f), (g), (h), (i), (j), or (k) of this Code, such officer, employee, or

lessee may provide for the removal of such vehicle, so long as signs have been posted to

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1	inform the public that vehicles so parked are subject to removal and, with respect to Section
2	6.01(i), so long as there is an attendant on duty or other facilities permitting the patron to pay
3	or remit the parking charges at the time the vehicle is first parked.
4	$\underline{(b)}$ The procedure for removal and impounding of vehicles shall be as is provided for
5	in applicable provisions of the San Francisco Transportation Traffic-Code and Sections 22850 to
6	22855 of the California Vehicle Code.
7	(c) Moreover, aAny vehicle stopped, parked, or left standing in such a manner as to
8	violate Sections 6.01(d), (e), (f), (g), (h), (i), (j), or (k) of this Code is an obstruction to the free
9	use of property and a nuisance within the meaning of Part III of the Civil Code of California
10	relating to nuisances and the abatement thereof.
11	
12	SEC. 6.10. PENALTIES.
13	(a) A person who violates Section 6.01(c), (d), (e), (f), or (g) of this Code shall be guilty
14	of an infraction and upon conviction thereof shall be punished for the first offense by a fine not
15	to exceed \$50; for the second offense committed within a one-year period by a fine not to
16	exceed \$100; for a third and each additional offense committed within a one-year's period by a
17	fine not to exceed \$250.
18	$\underline{(b)}$ This Section $\underline{6.10}$ shall not be deemed to contradict Section 6.02 of this Code
19	concerning the towing of vehicles in violation of Section 601(d), (f), or (g). Nor shall this Section
20	6.10 contradict or limit the ability of SFMTA to establish and impose fines and penalties pursuant to
21	the Transportation Code for parking violations on park property, subject to the approval of the
22	Recreation and Park Commission.
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1 SEC. 12.08. PARKING FEES ON RECREATION AND PARK PROPERTY.

2	(a) The following fees shall be charged for parking at the Kezar Parking Lot. The rates for
3	parking at the Kezar Stadium Parking Lot may be set by the San Francisco Municipal Transportation
4	Agency (SFMTA) in accordance with Section 6.14. Until such time as the SFMTA has set rates with
5	approval of the Recreation and Park Commission, the rates, which are subject to annual adjustment
6	under Section 12.20, shall continue to apply:

1	— (1) The daily fee for vehicles and trailers parking in the television compound during
2	football season and for televised soccer events shall be \$1,000.00 perday.
3	(2) The fee for automobile and tire manufacturer and/or dealer shows shall be \$2,500.00
4	per day for set up and breakdown and \$5,000.00 per day for the show.
5	(3) The fee for ear clubs shall be \$2,500.00 per day plus an additional \$1,250.00 for use of
6	the entire lot which includes the RV section.
7	(4) The fee for photography shoots shall be \$2,500.00 per day for use of the parking lot,
8	and \$4,000.00 per day for use of the stadium.
9	$\underline{(b)}$ Other Recreation and Park Property. The daily fee for parking on other
10	Recreation and Park property, except for garages and specifically designated parking lots
11	subject to separate fee-setting procedures, shall be from \$0.50 (fifty cents) to \$1.00 per hour,
12	the amount to be determined by the Recreation and Park Commission after considering the
13	costs of parking in the areas adjacent to the park property.
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15	SEC. 12.11. MARINA FEES.
16	The following fees shall be charged for goods and services at the San Francisco Marina
17	Small Craft Harbor:

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SEC. 12.35. GOLDEN GATE PARK CONCOURSE UNDERGROUND PARKING FACILITY.

The rates to be charged for parking in the Golden Gate Park Underground Parking Facility may be set by the SFMTA in accordance with Section 6.14. Until such time as the SFMTA has set rates with approval of the Recreation and Park Commission, the rates, which are <u>subject to annual adjustment under Section 12.20</u>, shall continue to apply be as follows:

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the

ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board

of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

Section 5. Future Updates to Park Code Sections 12.08 and 12.35. Park Code Sections 12.08(a) and 12.35(a) contain rates previously approved by the Board of Supervisors for parking at the Kezar Stadium Parking Lot and Golden Gate Park Concourse Underground Parking Facility. This ordinance approves of the San Francisco Municipal Transportation

1	Agency (SFMTA) setting new parking rates at those facilities with the approval of the
2	Recreation and Park Commission, but the rate-setting and approvals have not yet occurred,
3	so the existing rates in the Park Code, adjusted in accordance with Park Code Section 12.20,
4	shall continue to apply in the interim. The Recreation and Park Department is directed to
5	notify the City Attorney's Office in writing once SFMTA has commenced setting rates at those
6	facilities with approval of the Recreation and Park Commission. Upon receiving such notice,
7	the City Attorney's Office shall cause Sections 12.08 and 12.35 to be revised accordingly.
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9	Section 6. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors
10	intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles,
11	numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal
12	Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment
13	additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under
14	the official title of the ordinance.
