8	WHEREAS, Sonora Lane is the name of the public right of way between		
9	O'Farrell Street and Terra Anza Avenue, and runs parallel to Anza Vista and St.		
10	Joseph's Avenues, and is perpendicular to O'Farrell Street and Terra Anza Avenue; and		
11	WHEREAS, Sonora Lane is in the Anza Vista neighborhood and near the home		
12	of Mr. Vicha Ratanapakdee, an 84-year-old immigrant from Thailand, and where he		
13	lived with his family; and		
14	WHEREAS, Mr. Ratanapakdee was well known in his community for his hour-		
15	long walks each morning, a ritual that kept him vibrant and healthy during the pandemic		
16	and		
17	WHEREAS, On January 28, 2021, Mr. Ratanapakdee was violently shoved and		
18	tragically died shortly after the attack; and		
19	WHEREAS, Stop AAPI Hate, a California-based coalition, has recorded nearly		
20	7,000 hate incidents involving Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders nationwide since		
21	the beginning of the coronavirus pandemic; and		
22	WHEREAS, Mr. Ratanapakdee is survived by loving family members in both		
23	California and Thailand; and		
24	WHEREAS, Since his passing, Mr. Ratanapakdee's daughter and her husband		
25	have both worked incredibly hard to ensure survivors of these attacks and their families		

1	are supported through city services, law enforcement and the justice system; and			
2	WHEREAS, Mr. Ratanapakdee's daughter has also since worked to amplify the			
3	voices of Asian Americans and the Thai and Southeast Asian communities through her			
4	participation in marches, rallies, and many #stopAAPIHate events; and			
5	WHEREAS, Renaming Sonora Lane to "Vicha Ratanapakdee Way" would			
6	commemorate and memorialize Mr. Ratanapakdee's death as a symbol of a moveme			
7	towards equality, anti-discrimination, and solidarity with the Asian American and Pacific			
8	Islander Community; now, therefore, be it			
9	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors intends to rename Sonora Lane, to			
10	Vicha Ratanapakdee Way to honor his legacy and to make it clear that the City of San			
11	1 Francisco stands with its Asian American Pacific Islander communities during this			
12	extraordinarily difficult time; and, be it			
13	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors directs Public Works to			
14	initiate the City's street naming procedures, expeditiously process the required actions			
15	related to street renaming, coordinate with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors' Office			
16	regarding posted and published notice for the street renaming, and report to the Board			
17	on its findings so that the Board may officially rename the street.
