SF RISE will develop a plan to address learning loss during distance learning, increase enrollment of San Francisco youth in SFUSD schools, and enhance enrichment activities like music, arts, and sports at SFUSD schools. The SF RISE Working Group is charged with creating the plan and is made up of representatives from SFUSD's Superintendent, the Educators Unions working in SFUSD schools, the Department of Children Youth & their Families, and experts in the fields of child health, education philanthropy, and out of school academic and family support programs. The SF RISE Working Group will continue to meet throughout this academic year to refine its recommendations.
