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Subacute SNF Status Update

- COVID-19 paused subacute SNF planning efforts as DPH and potential hospital partners focused on responding to the pandemic
- In August 2021, DPH re-engaged with Milliman consulting to support planning and implementing an expansion of San Francisco's capacity for subacute care beds for Medi-Cal beneficiaries and vulnerable members of San Francisco.
- DPH will be re-visiting conversations with key stakeholders over the next several months
