[Apply for State Used Oil Payment Program]

Resolution authorizing the Department of the Environment to apply for annual grants from the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery for the purpose of increasing Used Motor Oil Recycling and Household Hazardous Waste Management.

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code (PRC) sections 48690 et seq. authorize the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), formerly known as the California Integrated Waste Management Board, to make payments of qualifying jurisdictions for implementation of their used oil programs as required by PRC Section 48690 et seq.; and,

WHEREAS, In furtherance of this authority CalRecycle is required to establish procedures governing the administration of the Used Oil Payment Program; and,

WHEREAS, CalRecycle's procedures for administering the Used Oil Payment Program require, among other things, an applicant's governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of the Used Oil Payment Program; and,

WHEREAS, The grant is available to the City and County of San Francisco from CalRecycle; and,

WHEREAS, Through a recurring grant cycle the City and County of San Francisco has annually entered into agreement with the State of California for implementation of used oil collection programs for the past fifteen (15) years; and,

WHEREAS, The grant is included in the annual budget process of the City and County of San Francisco and approved through the Annual Appropriation Ordinance; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Acting Director of the Department of the Environment, or a designee, is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of the City and County of San Francisco the Used Oil Payment Program application to CalRecycle; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Acting Director of the Department of Environment, or a designee, is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of the City and County of San Francisco all documents, including but not limited to, applications, contracts, payment requests, agreements, annual reports (including expenditure reports) and amendments hereto for the purposes of securing grant funds and to implement and carry out the purposes specified in the grant application; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco authorizes the submittal of an annual grant application to CalRecycle for all available grants under PRC Section 48690 et seq. and this authorization shall remain in effect for five (5) years from July 1, 2010.
