| 7  | WHEREAS, Public Resources Code (PRC) sections 48690 et seq. authorize the                    |
| 8  | Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), formerly known as the           |
| 9  | California Integrated Waste Management Board, to make payments of qualifying jurisdictions   |
| 10 | for implementation of their used oil programs as required by PRC Section 48690 et seq.; and, |
| 11 | WHEREAS, In furtherance of this authority CalRecycle is required to establish                |
| 12 | procedures governing the administration of the Used Oil Payment Program; and,                |
| 13 | WHEREAS, CalRecycle's procedures for administering the Used Oil Payment Program              |
| 14 | require, among other things, an applicant's governing body to declare by resolution certain  |
| 15 | authorizations related to the administration of the Used Oil Payment Program; and,           |
| 16 | WHEREAS, The grant is available to the City and County of San Francisco from                 |
| 17 | CalRecycle; and,   |
| 18 | WHEREAS, Through a recurring grant cycle the City and County of San Francisco has            |
| 19 | annually entered into agreement with the State of California for implementation of used oil  |
| 20 | collection programs for the past fifteen (15) years; and,                                    |
| 21 | WHEREAS, The grant is included in the annual budget process of the City and County           |

of San Francisco and approved through the Annual Appropriation Ordinance; now, therefore,

be it

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| 2  | designee, is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of the City and County       |
| 3  | of San Francisco the Used Oil Payment Program application to CalRecycle; and be it               |
| 4  | FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Acting Director of the Department of Environment, or                  |
| 5  | a designee, is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of the City and            |
| 6  | County of San Francisco all documents, including but not limited to, applications, contracts,    |
| 7  | payment requests, agreements, annual reports (including expenditure reports) and                 |
| 8  | amendments hereto for the purposes of securing grant funds and to implement and carry out        |
| 9  | the purposes specified in the grant application; and be it                                       |
| 10 | FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco authorizes the                       |
| 11 | submittal of an annual grant application to CalRecycle for all available grants under PRC        |
| 12 | Section 48690 et seq. and this authorization shall remain in effect for five (5) years from July |
| 13 | 1, 2010.   |
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
