Thanks so much for your support of the City's acquisitions of the Eula Hotel and Mission Inn during yesterday's budget and finance committee meeting. I'm reaching out on behalf of Compass Family Services to express our full support for the City's acquisition of the Panoramic Hotel at 1321 Mission, which includes up to 40 three-bedroom units (and hopefully additional units) for families. These units represent so much potential for our city's unhoused families: not only a safe place to sleep but also a stable foundation for physical health, emotional wellness, workforce participation, school attendance, and more. Compass and our family partners would be thrilled to support our families experiencing homelessness to access these units. As you know, our current housing portfolio for homeless families over-relies on rapid re-housing, including for the most vulnerable families, who sometimes return to homelessness when the subsidy ends. We need more supportive housing to diversify our family portfolio and support the most vulnerable families to achieve housing stability.

We're grateful to have your support for these projects, and as part of the D6 community, we want to voice our full support for the Panoramic acquisition before next week's committee vote.
