
This tree was not watered by Public Works/BUF for 6 months.



A Tree Watering Success story!

Mission Verde is a resident watering crew, regulated by Public Works. The 140-tree planting area is along 24th St between Potrero and Mission, including side streets.

By following Public Works' watering rules, **Mission Verde has a 100% watering success rate**.

If BUF can get 100% watering from a resident crew, why not better results from its own crew?

Questions and a way forward

Why are taxpayers paying **\$1.3 Million** to water 2,200 new trees, but only 30% of them are actually being watered? Where is the extra 70% or **\$900K going?**

The 2014 San Francisco Urban Forest Plan promised 50,000 new trees by 2034, or **16,500 new trees by 2021**. The total net gain as of 2021 is **only 300 trees!**

San Francisco sorely needs a new Urban Forest Plan.
