7	WHEREAS, How Weird Street Faire has been a much-loved showcase of electronic				
8	music, fashion, art, performance, food, unique vendors and creativity for the last 20 years; and				
9	WHEREAS, How Weird Street Faire takes place along 2nd Street between Clementina				
10	Street and Minna Street and along Howard Street between New Montgomery Street and 1st				
11	Street in a primarily commercial area; and				
12	WHEREAS, How Weird Street Faire provides an economic boost to businesses in the				
13	vicinity of the faire which is especially important as many businesses are currently trying to				
14	recover from the COVID-19 pandemic; and				
15	WHEREAS, How Weird Street Faire is classified as a full cost-recovery event and is				
16	required to reimburse the City for all police, fire, public works, and other expenses related to				
17	the event; and				
18	WHEREAS, Non-profit organizations and small businesses are struggling to operate in				
19	the City due to the high cost of labor, permitting, and services; and				
20	WHEREAS, How Weird Street Faire is produced by World Peace Through Technology,				
21	a non-profit organization that re-invests all event proceeds into the production of future events				
22	and donates the remaining proceeds to other non-profit organizations; and				
23	WHEREAS, How Weird Street Faire has in the past been a free event dependent upon				
24	attendee donations for a large portion of its budget; and

1	WHEREAS, Receipts from donations have not provided sufficient revenue to make				
2	necessary improvements to the staffing and public security elements of the event; and				
3	WHEREAS, The site of the How Weird Street Faire is approaching full capacity				
4	attendance but expanding the site is not possible due to permitting and residential access				
5	points; and				
6	WHEREAS, An admission-based event would help moderate attendance and provide				
7	additional revenue for event improvements, public safety, and community donations; and				
8	WHEREAS, The San Francisco Police Department (SFPD) made an initial				
9	recommendation for an admission fee for the dual purpose of crowd control and to provide				
10	funding for increased public safety measures; and				
11	WHEREAS, The organizers of the How Weird Street Faire have worked with SFPD and				
12	staff from the Interdepartmental Staff Committee on Traffic and Transportation ("ISCOTT") on				
13	all of their plans for the event, including the proposal to charge admission; and				
14	WHEREAS, In order to charge admission, How Weird Street Faire will close the				
15	sidewalks at each entry gate and event side streets, but will allow for public access through a				
16	lane marked "local access" at each entry gate; and				
17	WHEREAS, In the spirit of accessibility, no one will be turned away from How Weird				
18	Street Faire for lack of funds; and				
19	WHEREAS, How Weird Street Faire organizers will submit an access plan to allow free				
20	access to affected residents, employees, and business patrons; and				
21	WHEREAS, Approval of this access plan will be a requirement of their ISCOTT permit;				
22	now, therefore, be it				
23	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco				
24	urges ISCOTT to approve the application including the plan to allow for gated admission and				
25	a modest admission charge for the How Weird Street Faire.
