The City and County of San Francisco's FY 2021-22 and FY 2022-2023 Budget and Appropriation Ordinance includes this recurring grant; however, it does not meet the California Victim Compensation Board resolution requirements, thus, a separate resolution is necessary. Although we are not required to obtain a separate Board of Supervisors Resolution under Admin Code 10.170, the funding agency, the California Victim Compensation Board requires a separate copy of a Board of Supervisors Resolution.
