Ordinance retroactively authorizing the Office of the Mayor to accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$3,407,000 from Bloomberg Philanthropies, and amending Ordinance No. 109-21 (Annual Salary Ordinance File No. 210644 for Fiscal Years (FYs) 2021-2022 and 2022-2023) to provide for the addition of one grant funded Class 0904 Mayoral Staff XVI position (FTE 1.0) at the Office of the Mayor, two grant funded Class 1043 Engineer positions (FTE 2.0) at the Office of the City Administrator, and two grant funded Class 1053 Senior Business Analyst positions (FTE 2.0) at the Office of the City Administrator, for the period of October 1, 2021, through August 31, 2024.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

## Section 1. Findings

(1) The Office of the Mayor was awarded a grant in the amount of \$3,407,000 to establish the San Francisco Digital Innovation Office in the Office of the Mayor. The City was selected as part of an open application process, which closed in November 2020. The City was notified of the award via e-mail in April 2021, and received a draft grant agreement in September 2021.

- (a) The award period is from October 1, 2021 to August 31, 2024.
  - (b) Indirect costs can represent no more than 15% of the Program Budget.

## Section 2. Authorization to accept and expend grant funds.

- (a) The Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Office of the Mayor to accept and expend, on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, Bloomberg Philanthropies grant funds in the amount of \$3,407,000 to establish the Mayor's Innovation Team. The Mayor's Innovation Team will work to improve data analytics and digital innovation to advance government accountability and transparency for San Francisco residents.
- (b) The Office of the Mayor proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget, and indirect costs are hereby waived.
- (c) The total personnel budget for the five (5) new positions (5.0 FTE) is \$1,186,612 of the total grant award of \$3,407,000, for the period of October 1, 2021 to August 31, 2024. The balance of the grant award is allocated to pay for \$762,398 in contractual services; \$39,682 in Travel and Events; \$12,000 in Advertising, Media, and Outreach; \$88,182 in Supplies; \$11,515 in technological equipment; and \$120,000 for other Direct Operating Costs.
- (d) The grant requires the City to partially match the grant funds, either through additional general fund sources or philanthropic fundraising, equal to at least \$1,135,667, with one half secured by October 1, 2022 and the balance by October 1, 2023.

Section 3. Grant funded positions; Amendment to Fiscal Years 2021-2022, and 2022-2023-Annual Salary Ordinance.
