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11	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
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13	Section 1. The Administrative Code is hereby amended by adding Chapter 96D,
14	consisting of Sections 96D.1 through 96D.5, to read as follows:
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16	SEC. 96D.1. DEFINITIONS.
17	For purposes of this Chapter 96D:
18	"Domestic Violence" means the crime defined in Section 273.5 and the crimes punishable
19	under Section 243(e)(1), of the California Penal Code.
20	"Personal Identifying Information" means any information that can, on its own or in
21	combination with other information, be used to contact, track, locate, identify, or reasonably infer the
22	identity of, a specific individual.
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1	SEC. 96D.2. MONTHLY DOMESTIC VIOLENCE DATA REPORTING.
2	(a) On the third Friday of each month, the Police Department and the District Attorney shall
3	each transmit a written report to the Board of Supervisors. The report shall contain the following
4	information:
5	(1) The Police Department shall report:
6	(A) The number of calls for service for Domestic Violence that the Police
7	Department received from the Department of Emergency Management in the prior month; and
8	(B) The number of Domestic Violence cases that the Police Department
9	presented to the District Attorney for investigation and/or prosecution in the prior month, and of those
10	cases, the number in which a child or children were present and/or a firearm or firearms were present.
11	(2) The District Attorney shall report:
12	(A) The number of Domestic Violence cases that the District Attorney charged in
13	the prior month, and what charges were filed in those cases; and
14	(B) The number of Domestic Violence cases resolved in the prior month, and the
15	outcome of those cases, including disposition by dismissal, diversion, acquittal, conviction, release to
16	another court or agency, or other means.
17	(b) In addition to the reports required by subsection (a), above, the Police Department and the
18	District Attorney shall report the same information for the period September 1, 2019 to September 1,
19	2021 to the Board of Supervisors no later than December 1, 2021.
20	(c) The reports shall not include Personal Identifying Information.
21	(d) The reporting obligations under this Section 96D.2 are in addition to, and do not supplant,
22	any reporting obligations under Administrative Code Chapter 96A.
23	(e) This Section 96D.2 shall not be interpreted to require the Police Department or the District
24	Attorney to collect data but instead requires only that the Police Department and District Attorney
25	report available data.

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### **LEGISLATIVE DIGEST**

[Administrative Code - Domestic Violence Data Reporting]

Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to require the Police Department and the District Attorney to submit monthly reports to the Board of Supervisors regarding the number of cases of domestic violence.

#### **Existing Law**

Current City law does not require the Police Department or the District Attorney to submit monthly reports to the Board of Supervisors regarding the number of cases of domestic violence.

#### Amendments to Current Law

The proposal is an ordinance that would amend the Administrative Code to require the Police Department and the District Attorney to submit monthly reports to the Board of Supervisors regarding the number of cases of domestic violence.

The Police Department would report:

- The number of calls for service for Domestic Violence that the Police Department received from the Department of Emergency Management in the prior month; and
- The number of Domestic Violence cases that the Police Department presented to the District Attorney in the prior month, and of those cases, the number in which a child or children were present and/or a firearm was present.


The District Attorney would report:

- The number of Domestic Violence cases that the District Attorney charged in the prior month, and what charges were filed in those cases; and
- The number of Domestic Violence cases resolved in the prior month, and the outcome of those cases, including disposition by dismissal, diversion, acquittal, conviction, release to another court or agency, or other means.

In addition, the Police Department and the District Attorney would report the same information listed above for the period from September 1, 2019 to September 1, 2021.

The reports would not include any information identifying specific individuals.
