8	WHEREAS, ABX1 26 was passed by the California State Legislature and signed by
9	Governor Jerry Brown in June 2011, and was largely upheld by the California Supreme Court
10	in California Redevelopment Association v. Matosantos, P.3d, 12 Cal. Daily Op. Serv. 32
11	(Dec. 29, 2011); and
12	WHEREAS, That legislation established an Oversight Board responsible for the fiscal
13	management of the assets of the former City and County of San Francisco Redevelopment
14	Agency, other than affordable housing assets designated to it under California Health and
15	Public Safe Code sections 34180 and 34181; and
16	WHEREAS, State law requires the Redevelopment Successor Agency Oversight Board
17	to be composed of seven members selected as follows: three members appointed by the
18	Mayor and subject to confirmation by the Board of Supervisors; one member appointed by the
19	Bay Area Rapid Transit District, the largest special district, by property tax share, with territory
20	in the territorial jurisdiction of the former Redevelopment Agency; one member appointed by
21	the County Superintendent of Education to represent schools; one member appointed by the
22	Chancellor of the California Community Colleges to represent community college districts; and
23	one member appointed by the Mayor and subject to confirmation by the Board of Supervisors
24	to represent the largest number of employees currently employed by the former
