Resolution retroactively approving the original grant agreement, first amendment, and second amendment for Contract No. 1000009982 for the Mayor's Youth Employment and Education Program between the Japanese Community Youth Council and the City and County of San Francisco, acting by and through its Department of Children, Youth and Their Families, for a total term of July 1, 2018, through June 30, 2024, and for a total not to exceed amount of \$39,662,265.

WHEREAS, The Japanese Community Youth Council's Mayor's Youth Employment and Education Program (MYEEP) provides pre-employment training that utilizes peer cohorts to develop critical workplace skills, explore career interests, and increase financial literacy; and

WHEREAS, MYEEP serves more than 1,000 San Francisco youth annually; and WHEREAS, The Mayor's Youth Employment and Education Program fulfills the MYEEP Funding Strategy of the Department of Children, Youth and Their Families' Youth Workforce Development Service Area, as described in the department's Request for Proposals issued August 18, 2017; and

WHEREAS, The Department of Children, Youth and Their Families entered into a grant agreement with the Japanese Community Youth Council effective July 1, 2018, to June 30, 2023, with a not to exceed amount of \$24,750,000; and

WHEREAS, The Department of Children, Youth and Their Families amended the original grant agreement on October 23, 2020, to increase the grant amount by \$9,032,540 for a revised not to exceed amount of \$33,782,540; and

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco wishes to enter into a second amendment to the grant agreement with the Japanese Community Youth Council, effective on and after July 1, 2021, to increase the grant amount by \$5,879,725 for a revised not to exceed amount of \$39,662,265 and to extend the grant term to June 30, 2024; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the original grant agreement, first amendment, and second amendment to the grant agreement between the City and County of San Francisco and the Japanese Community Youth Council to support the MYEEP program during the period of July 1, 2018, to June 30, 2024, for a total not to exceed amount of \$39,662,265; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That within thirty (30) days of the modification being fully executed by all parties, the Department of Children, Youth and Their Families shall provide the final grant agreement to the Clerk of the Board for inclusion into the official file.
