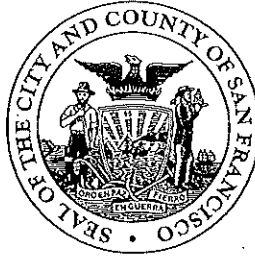

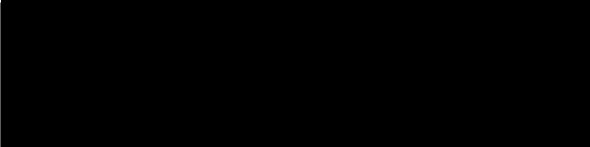

In my professional life, I served elders as a State of California licensed residential care facility for the elderly administrator, a Ca. licensed skilled nursing hospital administrator (LNHA 4619), a team member/owner of an employee owned elder care facility management company, Foresight Management Services, and as an administrative and social service consultant in our statewide network of facilities.

Over the years, I was the administrator of a 190 bed, multi level of care campus, a 102 bed skilled nursing facility, and a 45 bed skilled nursing hospital.

During my years in long term care administration, I was an officer in the local California Association of Healthcare Facilities (CAHF) San Francisco/San Mateo chapter and delegate to the statewide CAHF house of delegates.

As an administrator, I enjoyed volunteering as a preceptor, providing on site training in my facility for SF State gerontology masters candidates during their required administrator in training modules, including preparing them for state and federal board exams. My last student is now the skilled nursing facility administrator at the San Francisco Campus for Jewish Living on Mission and Silver.

Civic Activities:

I have served several terms as president of the Cayuga Neighborhood Improvement Association, beginning in 1995. Over the past 27 years, I have also served on the CNIA board in a number of capacities, including as delegate to the District 11 Council.

Prior to Covid, I was the Cayuga Park volunteer coordinator. Our main focus was the preservation of the exceptional art work/statuary in our park. I enjoyed time with the Little Learner program as a volunteer, teaching the students about the ecology of our park/natural area through hands on activities/adventures & about art preservation through offering them their own statue to paint ongoing. The volunteers will be reactivated as needed.

I participated in the advisory board which addressed community concerns regarding the development of the partially HUD financed elder housing site at 5199 Mission.

I have also participated in the evolution of what is now the Cayuga Community Connector program. My interest in Aging In Place models evolved over many years and I believe that the Connectors provide one ever evolving viable model which can be adapted by other communities.

Fiinally, I served on the Readl-Wheels paratransit advisory committee in San Mateo County.
