Vice Chair Mar, seconded by Member Cohen, moved that this Initiative Ordinance be AMENDED on Page 3, Line 8, by adding 'and Mission' after 'South of Market'. The motion carried by the following vote:

Member Cohen, seconded by Vice Chair Mar, moved that this Initiative Ordinance be AMENDED on Page 5, Line 22, by removing 'require Conditional Use authorization pursuant to Section 303 and shall' and 'additional' requirements; on Line 25 through Page 6, Line 3, by removing 'if a project would result in conversion of building space, where the prior use in such space was PDR of at least 5,000 square feet, Institutional Community of at least 2,500 square feet, or Arts Activities use, through removal, including through demolition of a building that is not unsound, or through change of use, such space' and inserting on Page 6, Line 3, 'such conversion shall, if located within the following zoning districts, require conditional use authorization under Section 303 and the space proposed for conversion'. The motion carried by the following vote:

Member Cohen, seconded by Vice Chair Mar, moved that this Initiative Ordinance be AMENDED on Page 6, Line 4, by removing the redundant 'PDR'. The motion carried by the following vote:

Member Cohen moved that this Initiative Ordinance be AMENDED on Page 6, Line 9, by removing 'if replaced on the same property or shall include one square foot of PDR, Institutional Community, or Arts Activities use for each square foot of the use proposed for conversion if replaced off-site.' Member Cohen moved that this Initiative Ordinance be AMENDED on Page 6, Lines 14 through 22, by modifying the grandfather provision to allow projects with environmental review submitted by June 14, 2016; and removing Subsection (a)(4). The motion carried by the following vote:

Member Cohen moved that this Initiative Ordinance be AMENDED on Page 6, Line 25, by adding 'and is subject to a deed restriction'. The motion carried by the following vote:

Vice Chair Mar, seconded by Member Cohen, moved that this Initiative Ordinance be AMENDED on Page 7, Line 17, to update the zone exemption by adding 'and any parcel zoned P on or after July 1, 2016.' The motion carried by the following vote:

Vice Chair Mar, seconded by Member Cohen, moved that this Initiative Ordinance be AMENDED on Page 8, Line 5, by inserting a new Section 7 to read as follows '(7) Any project where all of the residential units with the exception of the manager's unit are affordable housing units, as that term is defined in Section 406(b)(1).' The motion carried by the following vote:

Member Cohen moved that this Initiative Ordinance be AMENDED on Page 8, Line 7, by adding 'and Off-Site Replacement' after Subsection '(g) In Lieu Fee'; on Line 8 by adding 'and/or an off-site replacement option'; and on Line 11 by adding 'by ordinance' after Subsection '(h) The Board of Supervisors'. The motion carried by the following vote:
