200296 [Authorization to Borrow Funds - Short-Term Loan Program for SARS-CoV-2 Impacted Small Businesses - Treasurer-Tax Collector - Line of Credit Amount Not to Exceed \$20,000,000]

Sponsors: Ronen; Haney, Preston, Mar and Walton

Ordinance authorizing the Treasurer to secure a short-term line of credit in an amount not to exceed \$20,000,000, or in the alternative, partner with one or more financial institutions, for the purpose of providing short-term emergency unsecured loans to small businesses with a physical location in San Francisco that are unable to meet rent, mortgage, or other fixed operating costs as a result of the economic downturn caused by SARS-CoV-2. (Fiscal Impact)

Ordinance appropriating \$20,000,000 of short-term loan proceeds and \$600,000 of the General Reserve to the Office of the Treasurer's and Tax Collector to administer individual loans for small businesses impacted by SARS-COV-2, appropriating \$20,000,000 for loan default, and authorizing the Controller to reduce the loan default appropriation to the amount defaulted by June 30, 2021.
