Resolution approving an agreement with Creative Bus Sales, Inc. to procure 30 32-foot, low floor, diesel-hybrid buses and related tools, training, manuals, and spare parts through a procurement by the State of Georgia, in an amount not to exceed \$26,071,700 and for a term not to exceed six years to commence following Board approval. (Municipal Transportation Agency) (Fiscal Impact)

Chair Haney moved that this Resolution be AMENDED, AN AMENDMENT OF THE WHOLE BEARING SAME TITLE on Page 1, Lines 9-13, by removing 'WHEREAS, The San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) currently owns 30 32-foot Orion diesel-hybrid, which are the oldest vehicles in the fleet and past their useful life; and WHEREAS, The Orion vehicles are the smallest Muni vehicles and allow the SFMTA to serve hilltop neighborhoods with tight turns; and'; on Page 2, Lines 10-11, by adding 'WHEREAS, The Orion vehicles are the smallest Muni vehicles and allow the SFMTA to serve hilltop neighborhoods with tight turns; and'; on Page 2, Lines 20-23, by adding 'Based on the above, the SFMTA Board of Directors found that it is in the best interests of the City that the SFMTA procure the hybrid buses from Creative Bus Sales, Inc., through the Georgia Procurement; and WHEREAS,'; on Page 3, Lines 4-10, by adding 'WHEREAS, On February 5, 2021, the SFMTA, under authority delegated by the Planning Department, determined that the contract with Creative Bus Sales, Inc. for hybrid motor coach procurement is not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations Sections 15060(c) and 15378(b); and, WHEREAS, Under Charter Section 9.118, the Board of Supervisors must approve this Contract since it is an expenditure contract in excess of \$10 million dollars; and'; on Page 3, Line 14, by removing 'Based on the above'; on Page 3, Line 19, through Page 4, Line 2, by adding 'FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the SFMTA to approve any additions, amendments or other modifications to the Contract that the Director of Transportation, in consultation with the City Attorney, determines is in the best interest of the SFMTA, do not materially increase the obligations or liabilities of the SFMTA or City, or materially decrease the public benefits accruing to the SFMTA, and are necessary or advisable to complete the transactions contemplated and effectuate the purpose and intent of this Resolution, such determination to be conclusively evidenced by the execution and delivery by the Director of Transportation of any such documents; and be it'; and to make other clarifying and conforming amendments.
